- Monitor and co-ordinate logistics to ensure equipment and staff are on site when required;
- Work collaboratively with suppliers to find cost effective solutions for purchases and hires;
- Manage Health and Safety issues at Colour Sound Experiment Ltd Offices and onsite where appropriate.
